**Gilmore has a rich tradition of outstanding VCE success.
Our Year 12 academic results have consistently been above regional averages.**

For 2015, Gilmore College will offer:

- Two academic scholarships of \$200 (credit for school expenses) for students Entering Year 11. All scholarships are for 2 years for students who maintain an excellent academic record. Students can reapply for a further scholarship at the end of the two year period.
- Criteria for the award of scholarships will be a demonstration of the student's talents in academic, leadership and extra curricular activities.
- The closing date for applications is **Friday 16th October 2015**.
- Applications will be assessed by a panel of Gilmore College staff and a College Council representative. Successful applicants will be announced by late October.

At Gilmore College for Girls we believe that your daughter's achievements should be recognised and rewarded. We demonstrate this by actively pursuing the many scholarship opportunities available to young women. Past Gilmore students have been awarded:
